Current Projects

- FEMA Generator Grant – Grant was applied for in 2021. Final award was November 24, 2024.
 - Grant is 90%/10%. Total Subgrant amount \$822,580.00 and Navarro Mills WSC estimated contribution is \$82,258.00
 - Contracted Engineer – Schaumburg and Polk
 - Contracted Grant Administrator – Traylor & Associates
 - Awaiting final approval in order to put out for bids.
- CDBG – Subrecipient Grant Sponsored by Navarro County
 - Submitted plans for Plant #4 upgrades consisting of:
 - Installation of 30,000 gallon storage tank
 - Installation of 10,000 gallon pressure tank
 - Remove (2) 12,000 gallon storage tanks
 - Install high service pump
 - Nearing final approval in order to put out for bids.
- Alternate Capacity Request
 - Applied for ACR. Was awarded temporary ACR at Stations #1, 3 & 4.
 - Will collect data for 3 years and should receive permanent ACR
- TXDoT Bridge Replacement Water Line Relocations
 - 100% reimbursement
 - Relocate water lines at Starin & Richland Creeks on FM 744
 - Put out for bids and awarded to low bidder.
 - Completion expected to be May 2026
- TWDB PIF 25
 - Submitted application March 2025.
 - Did not have enough points to get accepted.
 - Will reapply in March 27
- Chlorine Gas Conversion
 - Requested from TCEQ for changing the disinfection at Plant # 2 & 3.
 - Switch from liquid bleach to chlorine gas
 - Longer lasting and more cost effective
 - TCEQ approved
 - Will be converting in 2026
- Yellow Cat Wind Project
 - Wind project expected to make 74 underground crossings and many surface crossings
 - Worked with Attorney to get a crossing agreement to protect Navarro Mills WSC
 - Have verbally agreed and awaiting executed agreement

Completed

- Water Contract
 - Negotiated a new water supply contract with the City of Corsicana.
 - Increased the amount of water available and extended to 20 years
- Water Storage Tank Cleaning
 - Contracted Ron Perin Water Technologies, Inc. to clean tanks.
 - Divers cleaned the interiors, removing silt and debris
- Properties for Pump Stations
 - Edwards property was purchased for Plant #3 expansion
 - Riojas property was condemned for Plant #3 expansion
 - Warren property was purchased for Plant #2 expansion
- Muller Meters
 - 255 meters were sent in for replacement and received
 - Working to remove all Mueller Hot Rod meters
- Purchase Diesel Fuel Tank
 - Purchased a 500 gallons diesel tank.
 - Bulk diesel cost is much less and more convenient
- District Boundary Map
 - Updated district boundary map to include 100% of the service area. Redistricted accounts
- Employee Safety Equipment
 - Purchased new signs, cones and lights for company vehicles
- Vehicle Purchases
 - Dodge truck wrecked, replaced with 2017 Ford F-250 with diesel
 - Toyota truck with costly repairs, replaced with Chevrolet Colorado
